Members are responsible for the proper management and governance of the trust in accordance with the requirements of the *Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2003* and are appointed by the Governor in Council on the recommendation of the Minister for Health.

The term of appointment for these positions is expected to be from 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2024.

The trusts require members with a range of skills and expertise in areas such as corporate governance, finance, business, strategic planning, law, management and community service, and with a knowledge and understanding of cemetery issues in their local area. Experience on public companies, community or statutory authority boards, and/or knowledge of public sector accountability frameworks is desirable.
