

NOTICE OF WORKS DEVELOPMENT OF BACKHAUS LAWN AREA

Remembrance Parks Central Victoria have scheduled required infrastructure works to take place at the Backhaus Lawn at the White Hills Remembrance Park commencing late March 2019.

The works are set to beautify the area and will allow RPCV to continue to create a serene place of reflection for all visitors, in line with our vision of nurturing enduring remembrance.

Initial works will commence with levelling of the area; with all garden edging and grave surrounds being removed. This will establish the foundations on which a lawn area can be landscaped. Works will include installation of irrigation and seeding of turf to establish a spacious area of lawn, hallmark to the tranquil simplicity of a lawn grave setting.

Works will include beautification of existing graves and also further development to extend the Backhaus Lawn, making room for future burials.

A maintenance program will be implemented upon completion of these works. This will ensure installation is successful and sustained to maintain the quality of the area for future generations.

We would like to apologise for any inconvenience caused by these works and thank you for your support and understanding during this period of necessary development.

Whilst works are being undertaken, RPCV require individuals to ensure items on each grave are confined to the concrete beam and do not extend onto the lawn area. If items are sitting on the lawn, RPCV staff will shift these items up onto the concrete beams to avoid damage to property.
